- (a) to (b) As reported by State Government of Haryana, drinking water facilities have already been extended to the Rohtak / Jhajjer and Kosli regions. Further to improve the water supply, 94 projects costing Rs. 92.96crore in Rohtak region, 122 projects costing Rs.173.01 crore in Jhajjar region and 78 projects costing Rs. 104.98 crore in Kosli region are in progress in these regions. The said improvement projects are likely to be completed by 30.06.2022, subject to availability of adequate funds.
