- (a) to (c) The Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs facilitates and assists States/Union Territories (UTs) including Maharashtra, in urban infrastructure development through its Missions/Schemes- Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT), Smart Cities Mission(SCM), Swachh Bharat Mission-Urban(SBM-U)and Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana (Urban)(PMAY-U) to improve the quality of life in cities and towns covered under these Missions/Schemes. Details of funds allocated, released, utilised and project status under these Schemes are given in Annex.**

(a) Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT)

State Annual Action Plans (SAAPs) for the entire Mission period worth Rs. 7,759.32 crore, including Central Assistance (CA) of 3,534.08 crore have been approved. Out of total committed CA of Rs. 3,534.08 crore, Rs. 1,532.52 crore has been released:

Under the Mission construction of Individual Household Latrines, Community Toilets, Public Toilets, Solid Waste Management Projects, Capacity Building Activities and Information, Education and Communication(IEC) Activities are undertaken. The SBM-U is scheduled to end on 02.10.2019. Projects undertaken under the SBM-U are required to be completed within the Mission period.

Under the Mission 9.83 lakh houses have been sanctioned in cities in 35 districts of the State. Out of this 3.67 lakh houses have been grounded for construction and 2.20 lakh have been completed. The Mission ends in 2022. All projects are required to be completed within the Mission period.
