(d) whether the Government has received any requests from passengers to restart the Dream Liner flight in Dubai- Kochi-Delhi sector and if so, the details thereof and the action taken thereon?

- (a) and (b): No, Sir. Only one Flight AI-020/AI-701 Routing Delhi-Kolkata-Delhi has been converted from Dreamliner to Air Bus A-320 aircraft w.e.f. 2nd July 2019 due to HAJ operations 2019.
- (c): Air India plans restarting/converting AI-020/701 Routing Delhi-Kolkata-Delhi & back from Air Bus A-320 aircraft to Dreamliner after concluding the HAJ operations 2019 i.e 15th September, 2019.
- (d): Air India has already started the Dreamliner service on the sector Delhi-Kochi-Dubai and vice versa effective 01st July 2019.
