Deaths of Animals due to Heat Wave

3197. SHRI A. GANESHAMURTHI:

Will the Minister of ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE be pleased to state:

- a) whether large number of animals and birds kept in zoos in many parts of the country died due to heat wave during the summer;
- (b) if so, the total number of animals and birds died during the last three years; zoo-wise;
- (c) whether the Government has taken/proposes to take any preventive measures to stop such deaths in the future; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE (SHRI BABUL SUPRIYO)

- (a)and(b) As informed by the Central Zoo Authority, 31 animals have died in recognized zoos due to heat wave in summer during the last three years. Zoo-wise details of death of animals and birds are given in the **Annexure**.
- (c)&(d) The preventive measures taken by the Government to stop such death includes:
 - 1. As per provision of the Schedule 5(4) of Rule 10 under the Recognition of Zoo Rules, 2009, all the zoos have been advised to provide feeding cells / kraals to serve as indoor enclosures for the animals during extreme weather conditions.
 - 2. Disaster / Contingency Management Plan is prepared for each zoo as part of its Master Plan. It includes specific measures to be adopted during extreme weather conditions.
 - 3. The Central Zoo Authority in association with the Indian Veterinary Research Institute, developed Protocol on Zoo Animal Health Management. It includes seasonal measures to be adopted by zoos.
