Will the Minister of ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether scientists have developed any plant with air purifying capabilities to clean polluted air in mineral, mining/ producing cities;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the time by which the use of such plants is likely to be made available to provide clean air to the people?

(a) to (c) 54 Air purifying units (WAYU) have been installed as pilot project for control of pollution at traffic intersection in Delhi by Central Pollution Control Board and efficiency WAYU is being assessed. Out of 54 devices, 10 nos. are installed at Anand Vihar, 14 nos. at ITO intersection, 06 nos. at Wazirpur Chowk, 11 Nos. at Shadipur and 13 Nos. at Bikaji Cama place.
