REVIEW OF NSDC

†324. SHRI SUSHIL KUMAR SINGH:

Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has reviewed the functioning of Skill Development Training Centres set up in various States/UTs by the National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) in the country and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the Government has collected details of Skill Development and Training Centres set up or proposed to be set up in Bihar and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government collects data regarding the number of under training students, education and expertise displayed by them in these Skill Development Centres;
- (d) the number of students provided training by these Skill Development Centres across the country during the last five years; and
- (e) the total number of students provided employment in Government and Private Institutions, State/UT-wise?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP (SHRI R. K. SINGH)

(a) Under Skill India Mission, Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) is implementing a flagship scheme known as Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) with an objective to provide skilling to one crore people under Short Term Training (STT), Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) and Special Project (SP) through accredited and affiliated training centres (TCs) across the country. The guidelines for PMKVY 2016-20 have various provisions relating to continuous as well as performance monitoring of training centres. For ensuring quality of training under the scheme, all accreditation and affiliation of training centres are done through an online portal SMART with inspections done by an independent third party assessment agency. Adding to the improved accreditation process, MSDE has initiated a process of continuous monitoring through various channels and mandatory re-accreditation every

year. Under this, self-audit reporting, call validations, surprise visits and monitoring through the skill Development Management Systems (SDMS) have been adopted.

Additionally PMKVY Monitoring Committee review and formulate framework on the critical cases related to monitoring issues of the stakeholders. A penalty grid has also been formulated by the Committee for taking action against erring / non compliant training centres / stakeholders.

- (b) Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) does not mandate establishing of skill center, but aims to encourage and promote Skill Development for the youth throughout the country by aligning itself with Common Norms guidelines. Under PMKVY, NSDC has a total of 357 operational Training Centres in the State of Bihar.
- (c) Under PMKVY, to enhance the scale and quality of the said scheme, the entire training life cycle of candidates starting from enrollment, training delivery, biometric based attendance, monitoring, standardization of assessment and certification process has been maintained.
- (d) & (e) Under PMKVY 2016-20, as on 12.06.2019, the yearwise number of candidates trained and placement reported by NSDC's approved Training Partners are as under:
