AYUSH HOSPITALS BY PSUS

3244. ADV. ADOOR PRAKASH:

Will the Minister of **AYURVEDA, YOGA AND NATUROPATHY, UNANI, SIDDHA AND HOMOEOPATHY (AYUSH)** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposed that the Public Sector Units (PSUs) have to open hospitals exclusively providing for traditional systems of medicine including Ayurveda across the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether National Thermal Power Corporation (NTPC) has agreed to open five such hospitals including Kayamkulam in Kerala; and
- (d) if so, the details and the present status thereof?

(a) & (b): The Ministry of AYUSH, in its efforts to increase the outreach of AYUSH Systems have requested Ministries/ Departments of the Government of India for integrating AYUSH Systems of Medicine through their Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs)/Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs) who have structure of Health facilities/ Hospitals under their respective jurisdiction

(c) & (d): National Thermal Power Corporation (NTPC), under Ministry of Power, has agreed to develop five Ayurveda Hospitals including one at Kayamkulam (Kerala).
