## **DISTRICT HOSPITALS**

#### 3246. SHRIMATI KIRRON KHER:

#### Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

(a) the details and number of district hospitals presently functioning in the country as on date, State/UT-wise including Punjab;

(b) whether the Government has any proposal/received any proposals from the States/UTs for upgradation of their district hospitals into medical colleges; and

(c) if so, the details thereof, State/UTwise along with the action taken by the Government in this regard?

### ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI ASHWINI KUMAR CHOUBEY)

(a) The details of district hospitals State/UT-wise including Punjab as on 28.06.2019 as uploaded by States/ UTs on Hospital Management Information System(HMIS) Portal, are placed as per Annexure-I.

(b) & (c): Under Centrally Sponsored Scheme for "Establishment of new medical colleges attached with existing district/referral hospitals", 82 new Medical Colleges are to be established in two phases. The fund sharing ratio between the Central Government and States is 90:10 for NE/Special Category States and 60:40 for other States.

Under Phase-I of the Scheme, 58 districts in 20 States/UT have been identified and approved. Total cost of establishment of one Medical College is Rs.189 crore. Funds to the tune of Rs.7507.70 crore have been released to the State/UT Governments for the approved medical colleges. 39 medical colleges have become functional. List of approved medical colleges is placed as per **Annexure-II**.

Further, under Phase-II of the Scheme, 24 new medical colleges in 8 States have been identified. The objective of the Phase-II of the scheme is to ensure the availability of one medical college in every 3 Parliamentary Constituencies and one Government medical college in each State. The total cost of establishment of one Medical College under this Phase is Rs.250 crore. The State Governments have identified the locations on Challenge mode. Out of 24 medical colleges, 17 have been approved till date and funds to the tune of Rs.1375.13 crore have been released to the State Governments. List of medical colleges under Phase-II is placed as per **Annexure-III**.
