**3314. SHRI PARBHUBHAI NAGARBHAI VASAVA:**

Will the Minister of **AYURVEDA, YOGA AND NATUROPATHY, UNANI, SIDDHA AND HOMOEOPATHY (AYUSH)** be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the Arogya Centres operational across the country, State/ UT-wise including Gujarat;
- (b) whether the need of Ayush doctors are increasing at these centres in the country, if so, the details thereof, State/ UT-wise along with the action taken/being taken by the Government in this regard;
- (c) whether the Government is in the process of identifying some Arogya Centres to deliver traditional medicinal services at the grass-root level; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof, State/UTwise and the time by which these are likely to be identified?

**ANSWER**

(a) to (d): Public Health is a State subject. Setting up of Arogya Centres comes under purview of State/UT Governments. However, Central Government is implementing Centrally Sponsored Scheme of National AYUSH Mission (NAM) in the country including Gujarat under which there is a provision of financial assistance to States/UTs for setting up of AYUSH Wellness Centres including Yoga & Naturopathy. State/UT Government including Gujarat may avail eligible financial assistance by projecting the same through State Annual Action Plan (SAAP) as per NAM guideline.
