- (a) whether the Central Advisory Board of Education (CABE) has recently urged the Government to implement 'Operation Digital Board' on the lines of Operation Blackboard of 1987 with the purpose of providing minimum basic digital education in all primary schools across the country; and
- (b) if so, the reaction of the Government in this regard?

(a) and (b) : In order to provide good quality education by effective use of technology and telecom services, the Central Advisory Board of Education (CABE), in its meetings held on 15th and 16th January, 2018 resolved to launch 'Operation Digital Board'. An Expert Committee was constituted to prepare the concept note and an approach paper defining specifications, modalities, financing systems for this project. The Expert Committee has given its recommendations which are under active consideration of the Government.
