CONVERSION OF NEHRU MUSEUM

- (a) whether it is proposed to convert the Nehru Museum Memorial and Library, Delhi as a monument for all former Prime Ministries of India;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor; and
- (c) the time by which the proposed monument is likely to be set up?

(a) to (c) : No, Sir. However, the Government of India has approved a proposal to set up a new Museum on the Prime Ministers of India in Teen Murti complex, New Delhi with the prime objective to broaden a better understanding of India's democratic ethos, create curiosity about the office, life and personality of Prime Ministers among the visitors and the public at large. The Museum is likely to be commissioned by October, 2020.
