#### **UPGRADATION OF ESIC DISPENSARIES**

#### 3483. ADV. ADOOR PRAKASH:

Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:

- (a)whether the Government has taken any decision to upgrade the dispensaries run by Employees' State Insurance Corporation (ESIC) as hospitals; and
- (b)if so, the State-wise details of dispensaries upgraded as hospitals and the present status of the same?

## ANSWER

# MINISTER OF STATE (IC) FOR LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT (SHRI SANTOSH KUMAR GANGWAR)

(a) & (b): Yes, Sir. Employees' State Insurance Corporation (ESIC) in its 172<sup>nd</sup> and 177<sup>th</sup> meeting held on 06.12.2017 and 19.02.2019 respectively, has taken decision to upgrade ESI dispensaries into 6/30 bedded hospital with norms as under:

## For 6 bedded Hospital:

• At least 5 doctors dispensary covering minimum 10,000 Insured person (IP) populations.

OR

- 5 doctors dispensary with average OPD attendance for last 3 years to be 200 per day.
- No Employees' State Insurance Corporation / Employees' State Insurance Scheme Hospital within 10 KM in metro cities and 20 KM in other cities.

## For 30 bedded Hospital:

- 20,000 IPs in a plain area or 15,000 IPs in North East Region/ Hilly area
- No ESIC/ ESIS health care delivery institution within the radius of 25 KM Based on these norms, no proposal has been received from State Governments for upgradation of dispensaries into 6/30 bedded hospitals.
