#### **CROP INSURANCE UNDER RWBCIS**

3806. SHRI AJAY NISHAD:

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE कृषि एवं किसान कल्याण मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) the rules under which farmers are provided insurance under Restructured Weather Based Crop Insurance Scheme (RWBCIS);
- (b) the name of the crops and perennial crops covered under this scheme;
- (c) the features in which this scheme is different from Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana;
- (d) the details of the farmers benefited under Restructured Weather Based Crop Insurance Scheme during the last three years, State/UT-wise; and
- (e) the reasons for preparing a separate Restructured Weather Based Crop Insurance Scheme?

#### ANSWER

(a) to (e): With a view to provide protection against likely yield loss due to adverse weather parameters, especially to commercial/horticultural crops or crops for which past yield data is not available, weather index based Restructured Weather Based Crop Insurance Scheme (RWBCIS) has also been introduced by the Government from Kharif 2016 season in the country alongwith yield index based Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana (PMFBY).

Similar to PMFBY, RWBCIS is available to all States/Union Territories and optional/voluntary for the States and they have to select insurance company, notify the crops & areas and provide weather data of current season to settle the claims under the scheme. The basic difference between the PMFBY and RWBCIS is in its methodology for settlement of claims. Under PMFBY coverage and settlement of claims is made on the yield data based on requisite number of Crop Cutting Experiments (CCEs) submitted by the concerned

State Government. Hence, crops especially perennial/horticultural crops for which yield data based on authentic methodology is not available can not be covered under PMFBY. These crops can now be covered under RWBVIS, which provides insurance protection/ admissible claims to the eligible farmers against adverse weather incidence, such as deficit or excess rainfall, high or low temperature (including heat wave, cold wave, frost), humidity etc. which are deemed to adversely impact the crop. Claims under RWBCIS are worked out if observed trigger value falls below or above, the notified trigger value. Claims per unit will be calculated using following formula depending upon index definition:

Claims per Unit = (Difference between Observed & Notified index value) X Notional Payout

Overall claims will be claims per unit X Number of Units
