- (a) whether the Government proposes to provide sugar at affordable price on the lines of the Public Distribution System (PDS) for foodgrains;

(a) & (b): Under the sugar subsidy scheme, introduced w.e.f. June 2013, after de-regulation of sugar sector, sugar is already being made available through Public Distribution System (PDS) at affordable price. The coverage of sugar subsidy scheme targeted Below Poverty Line (BPL) population [inclusive of poorest of poor person in the country i.e. Antyodaya Anna Yojana (AAY) families] and all the population of North Eastern States/Special Category States/Hilly States and Island Territories. However, with effect from June, 2017, the Government has reviewed the Sugar Subsidy Scheme and restricted the coverage of the scheme to AAY families.

(c): The Central Government is reimbursing a fixed subsidy of Rs. 18.50 per kg @ 1 kg of sugar per month per AAY families to participating States/UTs.
