REVIEW OF SAGY

3867. SHRI RAHUL KASWAN:

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to review the Saansad Adarsh Gram Yojana(SAGY) in order to remove the problem being faced by the Peoples' representatives therein;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to allocate funds especially for this programme; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

(a) & (b): There is no proposal to review the Saansad Adarsh Gram Yojana (SAGY) as of now. However, SAGY is reviewed periodically by the Ministry of Rural Development. The Ministry has evolved a comprehensive multilevel and multi-tool system of monitoring and evaluation of the implementation of its programmes which include review by the Union Ministers, Performance Review Committee meetings, National Level Monitors, Area Officers Scheme, Concurrent Evaluation and Impact Assessment studies. Concurrent monitoring mechanisms include the progress updated by States/Districts through SAGY website regarding identification of the Gram Panchayats, progress tracking of Village Development Plans, and the progress reported for Panchayat Darpan indicators.

(c) & (d): Under the Saansad Adarsh Gram Yojana framework, the development of Gram Panchayats has been envisaged through the convergence and implementation of existing Government Schemes and Programmes under the administrative control of respective Ministries. There is no proposal under consideration to allocate funds specially for this programme.
