- (c) whether the Government has consulted all the stakeholders before setting up of a new public sector unit, if so, the details and outcome thereof; and
- (d) the time by which the new public sector unit is likely to start functioning?

- (a) & (b) Railways are considering creation of a Government-owned Company nomenclature "Indian Railways Rolling Stock Company (IRRSC)". Existing Production Units are expected to become a part of this Umbrella Company in a phased manner. This step will make India an international hub for railway rolling stock manufacturing provide better benefits to employees, improve efficiency, create employment, enable access to latest technology and attract investments.
- (c) The process of consultations with stakeholders has commenced and will continue as part of this initiative.
- (d) Necessary steps are being taken to create the new entity following the due process.
