**STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) AND (b) OF
UNSTARRED QUESTION NO. 3959 BY SHRI JAYANT SINHA
TO BE ANSWERED IN LOK SABHA ON 17.07.2019 REGARDING
ELECTRIFICATION IN JHARKHAND**

(a) As on 01.07.2019, in the State of Jharkhand out of 2,585 Route Kilometer (RKM) of Broad Gauge network, 1,925 RKM i.e. 74.46% have been electrified.

(b) Electrification work is in progress on Koderma-Hazaribagh-Barkakana-Ranchi (203 Route Kilometer) rail line which is passing through Hazaribagh and Ramgarh districts of the State of Jharkhand.

Koderma-Barkakana (136 Route Kilometer) has been commissioned on electric traction. Balance portion i.e. Barakakana-Ranchi (67 Route Kilometers) New line work is in progress. Electrification will also be completed along with new line.
