DELAY IN JOLARPET-KRISHNAGIRI RAILWAY PROJECT

4081. DR. A. CHALLAKUMAR:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the proposed Jolarpet-Krishnagiri railway project is getting delayed resulting in huge cost overturn;
- (b) if so, the details of the project and the reasons for the delay in its execution;
- (c) the details of funds spent so far on this project; and
- (d) the steps taken by the railways to expedite the execution of this project to check any further cost escalation?

- (a) and (b): Surveys for Jolarpettai-Hosur via Krishnagiri new line were conducted during 2000-01, 2005-06, 2008-09 & 2010-11 to assess feasibility of taking up the project. As per survey completed in 2010-11 the cost of 101 Km new line was ₹ 688 crore with Rate of Return (-) 2.25%. Project being financially unremunerative could not be taken forward. However, a fresh survey has been sanctioned in 2018-19. Survey has been taken up.
