CHECK ON MANUFACTURING AND SALE OF SUB-STANDARD HELMETS

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS सड़क परिवहन और राजमार्ग मंत्री

be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is aware of increasing number of manufacturers and sellers of sub-standard helmets resulting in increase in the number of accidental deaths involving two-wheeler in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof along with the reaction of the Government thereto;
- (c) the steps being taken by the Government to check and prevent manufacturing and sale of such sub-standard helmets in the country;
- (d) whether the Government proposes to reduce prices of good quality helmets so as to encourage use of such helmets by a larger number of people; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI NITIN JAIRAM GADKARI)

- (a) & (b) As per information provided by Police Departments of all States and UTs, total number of persons killed due to non-wearing of helmet was 10135 in 2016 and 35975 in 2017. As per Section 129 of Motor Vehicle Act, 1988, every person driving or riding (otherwise than in a side car, on a motor vehicle of any class or description) shall, while in a public place, wear protective headgear confirming to the standards of Bureau of Indian Standards.
- (c) to (e) The ministry has issued draft Helmets (Quality Control) order, 2018 for inclusion of protective Helmets for Motorcycle riders as per IS 4151 under the mandatory BIS certification.
