Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

(a) the total number of dams in the country at present, State/UT-wise;

(b) whether the Government has prepared/proposes to prepare any action plan to enhance the present capacity of the dams and canals to increase the present area under irrigation in the country;

(c) if so, the details thereof and the name of such dams and canals, location-wise;

(d) the funds allocated for the purpose along with the time by which the work is likely to be completed; and

(e) the area of land likely to be benefited therefrom, State/UT-wise?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR JAL SHAKTI & SOCIAL JUSTICE AND EMPOWERMENT

(SHRI RATTAN LAL KATARIA)

(a) Central Water Commission (CWC) maintains National Register of Large Dams (NRLD) based on information received from the State Governments. As per NRLD, there are 5334 large dams completed and 411 large dams under construction stage in the country. State/UT-wise distribution of large dams is at **Annexure-I**.

(b) to (e) Water being a State subject, construction, maintenance and operation of dams and canals including enhancement of their capacity is primarily States' responsibility. Central Government provides technical and financial assistance through various schemes such as Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana (PMKSY) - Accelerated Irrigation Benefits Programme (AIBP). During 2016-17, ninety-nine on-going Major/Medium irrigation projects under PMKSY- AIBP have been prioritized in consultation with States, for faster completion of ongoing Major/Medium Irrigation (MMI) Projects including ten projects under Extension, Renovation & Modernization (ERM) scheme. The details of ERM projects under PMKSY along with Central Assistance (CA) released, irrigation potential created and districts benefitted are at **Annexure-II**.
