# THE MINISTER OF STATE (IC) OF THE MINISTRY OF AYURVEDA, YOGA & NATUROPATHY, UNANI, SIDDHA AND HOMOEOPATHY (SHRI SHRIPAD YESSO NAIK)

(a): Forests are the main source of medicinal plants and the conservation, resource augmentation and sustainable utilization of these resources is also one of the objectives of National Medicinal Plants Board (NMPB). To meet this objective of NMPB, the different State Forest Departments in the Country including Kerala Forest Department implements various projects sanctioned by NMPB on In-situ/ Ex-situ Conservation, Resource Augmentation and sustainable harvesting of medicinal plants.

(b): The State/UT-wise detail of number of projects supported by NMPB on Conservation, Resource Augmentation and sustainable harvesting of medicinal plants till 2018-19 is at **Annexure.**

(c): Yes, the NMPB has been able to bring improvement in availability of medicinal plants in the Country. In this regard, the NMPB has supported more than 96738 hectare area till 2018-19 for conservation and resource augmentation of medicinal plants in wild. In addition, NMPB, Ministry of AYUSH has also supported more than 220476 hectare area till 2018-19 under cultivation of medicinal plants for the availability of medicinal plants.
