### MIGRATION OF DOCTORS

### 4356. SHRI CHANDESHWAR PRASAD:

## Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether a number of senior doctors have left All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), Safdarjung and Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia hospital recently to serve in private hospitals in Delhi;
- (b) if so, the number of such doctors who left during the last one year and the reasons therefor; and
- (c) the remedial measures being taken by the Government to check the migration of senior doctors from 'AIIMS' and other Central Government Hospitals in Delhi?

# ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (SHRI ASHWINI KUMAR CHOUBEY)

- (a) & (b): During the last one year, 10 doctors from AIIMS, New Delhi, 15 doctors from Safdarjung Hospital & Vardhman Mahavir Medical College and 1 doctor from Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia hospital have resigned or taken voluntary retirement on personal ground.
- (c): The doctors at AIIMS and other Central Government hospitals in Delhi are being paid salary and allowances as per recommendations of 7<sup>th</sup> CPC and have been provided a conducive environment for growth of faculty members. Many doctors have resigned for personal reasons.
