- (a) the details of the schemes for the welfare of personnel working in the electronic and print media along with the amount allocated/ utilized for the purpose in the last three years; and
- (b) whether any schemes or proposals are under consideration to provide boarding facilities in circuit house, toll free travel and providing other facilities to the accredited reporters and if so, the details thereof?

(a) Ministry of Information & Broadcasting implements a 'Journalist Welfare Scheme' to provide one time ex-gratia relief on urgent basis to journalists /Media Personnel or their families under extreme hardship on account of death of journalists and to the journalists in case of permanent disability, major listed ailments and in case of accidents causing serious injuries necessitating hospitalization. The amount allocated/utilized in the last three years is as under :-
