- To develop suitable patterns of teaching in all branches of film and television, both at under-graduate and post-graduate levels, so as to establish high standards of film and television education in India
- To facilitate regular inflow of fresh ideas and new techniques in the field of cinema and television and a corresponding outflow of trained personnel imbibing these ideas and techniques
- To produce trained man-power both for the growing needs of the film industry and television organizations in India, and particularly to organize the inservice training programme for television personnel
- To depute students and members of the staff of the Institute to participate in seminars, conferences, workshops, training courses and the like, in India and abroad, through fellowships, scholarships, and otherwise
- To cooperate or collaborate with other national and/or foreign institutes and institutions and organisations in the field of film television and the performing arts.
- To promote quality film education by conducting short courses across the country.
