Subsidy on PNG

Will the Minister of PETROLEUM AND NATURAL GAS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has any proposal to give subsidy to Piped Natural Gas (PNG) consumers for domestic purpose;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) if not, the reason therefor;
- (d) whether the Government is planning to extend the subsidised gas to LPG users and not to PNG users; and
- (e) if so, the time by when the final decision in this regard is likely to be taken?

(a) to (e) Domestic gas is being allocated to various sectors as per Gas Utilization Policies of the Government issued from time to time and availability of gas. Domestic gas, which is cheaper than imported gas, has been allocated to meet the entire requirement of PNG (Domestic) and Compressed Natural Gas (CNG) (Transport) segments of City Gas Distribution (CGD) sector and it has been kept under no cut category. Further, allocation of domestic gas to Liquefied Petroleum Gas (LPG) plant is also covered under order of priority.
