CRITERIA FOR SETTING UP OF KV

†4675. SHRI BHAGIRATH CHAUDHARY: SHRI PANKAJ CHAUDHARY:

Will the Minister of HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has fixed any criterion to set up Kendriya Vidyalayas(KVs) in the country and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the details of KVs opened in the country during the last five years and the current year, State, district and location-wise along with the criteria/basis on which these opened;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to set up new KVs in each and every district of the country especially at headquarter of Kekri sub-division in Ajmer, Rajasthan and in the district of Uttar Pradesh which do not have any KV during 2020-21 and if so, the details thereof;
- (d) whether the Government proposes to make the terms and conditions easier for the allotment of land for setting up of new KVs in the country; and
- (e) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (SHRI RAMESH POKHRIYAL 'NISHANK')

(a) Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs) are opened primarily to cater to the educational needs of the children of transferable Central Government Employees including Defence & Para-Military personnel by providing a common programme of education. Proposals for opening of new KVs are considered only if sponsored by Ministries or Departments of the Government of India/State Governments / Union Territories Administrations thereby committing resources for setting up a new KV as well as the availability of necessary sanction of the Government. The proposals received from various sponsoring authorities for opening of new KVs also have to compete among other proposals under the "Challenge Method".

The proposals also need to satisfy the following mandatory conditions:-

- (i) Sponsoring Agency has to provide land, free of cost on permanent transfer / 99 years lease at the nominal rent, i.e., @ Re.1/- per annum, measuring 2.50 acres to 5.00 acres in metropolitan cities, Hyderabad & Bengaluru, Left Wing Extremism (LWE) districts / Hill areas / North Easter Region (NER) including the State of Sikkim and land measuring 5.00 acres to 10.00 acres fairly levelled in other locations, as the case may be.
- (ii) An independent rent-free temporary accommodation consisting of 15 rooms for running the school of the size 7m x 7m with adequate space till the time permanent Vidyalaya building is constructed by KVS on the land provided by Sponsoring Authority.
- (iii) Residential accommodation to be provided for at least 50% of staff posted in the proposed Vidyalaya.
- (iv) Concentration of at least 500 employees of Defence/Central Govt./ Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs) individually or jointly at the station.(200 in case of LWE districts/Hill areas/NER).
- (v) Availability of minimum 200 students of the aforesaid priority categories for enrolment in the proposed KV.
- (b) The state, district and location wise details of 120 KVs opened in the country during the last five years and the current year are annexed.
- (c) No such decision has been taken by the Government for setting up of new KVs in each district of the country and in the districts of Uttar Pradesh which do not have any KVs. Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan (KVS) has informed that no proposal in prescribed proforma for opening of a new KV at Kekri Sub-Division, Ajmer District, Rajasthan has been received from the District Collector, Ajmer through State Government so far.
- (d) No such proposal is under consideration at present.
- (e) Does not arise.
