Will the Minister of FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING

be pleased to state:

- (a) the number of milk dairy cooperatives running at present in Bihar along with the details of the production of milk during each of the last three years, district-wise;
- (b) whether any special efforts have been made by the Government to increase milk production per cattle in Bihar;
- (c) whether the Government has any plan to establish/open new Dairy Science/ Dairy Technical Colleges in the country particularly in Bihar; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

- (a) Government of Bihar has informed that 16683 number of dairy cooperatives are functional in the network of Bihar State Milk Cooperative Federation Ltd. (COMFED). District wise annual milk production in Bihar during 2015-16, 2016-17 & 2017-18 is **annexed**.
- (b) In order to complement and supplement the efforts made by the State to increase milk production per cattle Government is implementing following schemes in the country including Bihar:
 - (i) Rashtriya Gokul Mission (RGM)
 - (ii) Breed Improvement Institutes: Seven Central cattle Breeding Farms (CCBF)
 - (iii) National Dairy Plan- Phase I
- (c) As per the information furnished by ICAR, Government has no plan to establish/open new Dairy Science/ Dairy Technical Colleges in the country.
