- (a) whether the Government intends to extend Minimum Support Price to coffee growers across the country; and
- (b) if not, the reasons therefor?

कृषि एवं किसान कल्याण मंत्री (SHRI NARENDRA SINGH TOMAR)

(a) & (b): There is no proposal under consideration of the Government to extend Minimum Support Price (MSP) to coffee growers. Coffee being an export oriented commodity, the domestic procurement prices of coffee are dependent and aligned to the international prices. As nearly, 75% of Indian Coffee is exported, the Indian coffee exporters announce their purchase price based on international market price only.
