(a) to (e): The Vidarbha Intensive Irrigation Development Programme (VIIDP) was implemented in the State of Maharashtra as a sub-scheme of Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana (RKVY) from 2012-13 to 2015-16. Implementation of VIIDP as a sub-scheme of RKVY was discontinued from 2016-17. The year wise amount released and expenditure under the programme from 2012-13 to 2015-16 is as under:
