- (a) the present status of Chennai-Bengaluru industrial corridor;
- (b) whether the work of land acquisition for the project has been completed;
- (c) if so, the details thereof and if not, the present status thereof;
- (d) the total cost of the industrial corridor and the amount spent so far, year-wise;
- (e) the contribution of funds by Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) and the details of the execution of the project; and
- (f) the time by which the corridor is likely to be completed?

ANSWER

वाणिज्य एवं उद्योग मंत्री (श्री पीयूष गोयल) THE MINISTER OF COMMERCE & INDUSTRY (SHRI PIYUSH GOYAL)

- (a): Perspective Plan for overall Chennai Bengaluru Industrial Corridor (CBIC) has been completed and three nodes namely (i) Krishnapatnam (Andhra Pradesh), (ii) Ponneri (Tamil Nadu) and (iii) Tumakuru (Karnataka) have been identified for development. Special Purpose Vehicles (SPVs) for Krishnapatnam and Tumakuru nodes have been incorporated and detailed master planning and preliminary engineering activities are in progress for these two nodes.
- (b)&(c): Land acquisition is responsibility of the respective State Government(s) and following land parcels have been identified for development:
 - (i) Krishnapatnam, Andhra Pradesh (14000 acres)
 - (ii) Ponneri, Tamil Nadu (21966 acres)
 - (iii) Tumakuru, Karnataka (9630 acres)

Land acquisition process has been initiated by the concerned State Government(s).

(d)to(f): Total cost of the project at this stage cannot be ascertained as project development activities are in progress. The details of the amount spent so far year-wise on project development activities are as under:
