- (c) the fund allocation made by the Government along with the amount required for completion of this railway line project; and
- (d) the time by which the said project is likely to be completed?

- (a) to (d): Yes, Sir. Survey for Naharkatia Deomali Margherita new line was sanctioned in two phases:
- (i) Survey for new line between Naharkatia and Deomali (20 km) was sanctioned in 2016-17. Field survey work has been completed and survey report is under preparation. Final view will be taken after receipt and complete examination of survey report.
- (ii) Survey for new line between Margherita and Deomali (25.97 km) was sanctioned in 2016-17. Survey has been completed and as per survey report, the cost of the project is ₹999.36 crore with RoR (-) 7.97%. Project could not be taken forward as it was financially unviable and Indian Railways having large shelf of ongoing new line projects.
