- (c) whether the Ministry has sanctioned/released any funds for augmentation of mobile/telephone network in the aforesaid region out of Universal Service Obligation Fund in the last five years; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor?

- (b) Total 125 number of Mobile Towers in Ladakh region (Kargil-72 & Leh-53) are provisioned under the USOF Scheme for providing connectivity to the 361 villages of uncovered areas of Ladakh & Kargil (J&K region), Border area and other priority areas.
