OPERATIONS AT ADHARTAL RAILWAYS STATION

†5251. SHRI RAKESH SINGH:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to start operation of trains from Adhartal Railway Station, Jabalpur under the West Central Railways Zone;**
- (b) if so, the details thereof;**
- (c) whether the Government has taken action on an access road to Adhartal besides providing facilities therein; and**
- (d) if so, the details thereof?**

ANSWER

- (a) & (b) Presently, Adhartal station lacks basic infrastructural facilities for originating/ terminating of train services. As such, it is not feasible to operate originating trains from Adhartal.**
- (c) & (d) Adhartal is a Non-Suburban Grade (NSG-6) category station dealing with 280 passengers on an average per day. All minimum essential amenities have been provided as per norms. However, upgradation/modernization of railway stations is a continuous and ongoing process and works in this regard are undertaken depending upon need, volume of the passenger traffic and inter-se priority subject to availability of funds.**
