SHORTAGE OF DRIVERS

5314. SHRI M. SELVARAJ:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS सड़क परिवहन और राजमार्ग मंत्री

be pleased to state:

- (a) whether it is a fact that there is a shortage of approximately 22 lakh drivers across the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) the reaction of the Government thereto?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS (SHRI NITIN JAIRAM GADKARI)

- (a) & (b) Shortage of truck drivers is an issue which has been highlighted by various transport organisations. Ministry has not carried any study to assess the exact figures of shortage of drivers.
- (c) Ministry has proposed to waive off mandatory educational qualification for truckers and bus drivers for seeking a driving licence. A draft notification vide GSR 431(E) has been issued on 18-06-2019 regarding omission of rule 8 (minimum educational qualification) in the Central Motor Vehicles Rule, 1989.
