STATUS OF FOUR-LANING PROJECTS IN ASSAM

5365. SHRI GAURAV GOGOI:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

(a) the present status of four-laning projects on NH-37 (Jorhat-Golaghat) and NH-39 (Numaligarh-Dimapur) in Assam; and

(b) the time by which the work on the said projects is likely to be completed?

(a) & (b) The work of four-laning of Numaligarh-Jorhat Section (except Deragoan bypass) of NH-37 in Assam, having a length of 39.72 Km is under progress. Present progress is 29% and the work is expected to be completed by May 2020. The stretch from Numaligarh-Dimapur Section of NH-39 is proposed under Economic Corridor of Bharatmala Pariyojna and is at feasibility study stage.
