- (a) the details of proposals received by the Government under Urban Infrastructure Development Scheme for Small and Medium Towns during the last three years and the current year, State/ UT-wise;**
- (b) the details of proposals cleared and funds sanctioned thereunder during the said period, State/UT-wise; and**
- (c) the details of proposals lying pending with the Government, State/UT-wise and the reasons therefor along with the reaction of the Government for their clearance?**

(a): The Urban Infrastructure Development Scheme for Small and Medium Towns (UIDSSMT) component of Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission (JnNURM) came to an end on 31 March, 2014. No proposals thereafter, received from State/Union Territory Governments.

However, all those projects of UIDSSMT in which 50% or more of the Central Assistance had been released and physical progress was 50% or more as on 31.03.2014 or were sanctioned during Transition Phase (01.04.2012-31.03.2014) of the Mission, were approved for funding under AMRUT upto 31 March, 2017.
