## **Standard for being Minority**

## ANSWER MINISTER OF MINORITY AFFAIRS (SHRI MUKHTAR ABBAS NAQVI)

- (a) The Central Government notifies minority communities in consultation with various stakeholders under Section 2(c) of National Commission for Minorities (NCM) Act, 1992.
- (b) The population of Sikhs, Christians, Jains, Buddhists and Muslims in the country, as per Census 2011, is as given below:-
