Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to supply piped drinking water to all villages of the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the percentage of villages which are being provided water at present through taps under the piped drinking water scheme, State-wise; and
- (d) the number of villages which are targeted to be provided piped drinking water in the current year, State-wise?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FORJAL SHAKTI (SHRI RATTAN LAL KATARIA)

(a)to (d)As announced in the Union Budget Speech 2019-20, it has been envisaged to ensure piped water supply to all rural households by 2024 under the Jal Jeewan Mission. This Programme, under the Department of Drinking Water and Sanitation, will focus on integrated demand and supply side management of water at the local level, including creation of local infrastructure for source sustainability like rainwater harvesting, groundwater recharge and management of household wastewater for reuse.

Under National Rural Drinking Water Programme (NRDWP), this department maintains information regarding coverage of tap water connections in terms of individual households. As per information entered by States on Integrated Management Information System (IMIS) of this Ministry, State-wise details of individual householdstap connections through Piped Water Supply (PWS) and remaining households to be provided tap connections, is at **Annexure**.
