- (a) whether the funds have been allocated under the Swachh Bharat Mission-Gramin (SBM-G) for the financial year 2019-20;
- (b) if so, the funds allocated/released/utilized during the financial year 2019-20 State-wise; and
- (c) the component-wise expenditure of funds for the said period such as for toilets Information, Education and Communication (IEC), HR and Solid and Liquid Waste Management (SLWM) etc.?

ANSWER MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF JAL SHAKTI (SHRI RATTAN LAL KATARIA)

- (a) Yes, Sir.
- (b) Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin) (SBM-G) is demand driven scheme, hence fixed State/UT-wise allocation of funds is not made under this programme. During the financial year 2019-20 (as on 23.7.2019), funds amounting to Rs.4360.52 crore have been released to the States/UTs as Performance Incentive Grants under World Bank support to SBM-G. State/UT-wise details of the same are given at **Annexure**.
- (c) Component-wise expenditure of funds under SBM(G) during the financial year 2019-20 as reported by the States/UTs on the online Integrated Management Information System (IMIS) of SBM(G) is as under:
