Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the on-going/pending NH projects in the country along with the funds allocated, sanctioned and utilised for the purpose during the last three years and the current year, State/UT-wise;
- (b) whether some of these projects are facing huge cost/ time overrun and if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor along with the initial estimated cost and targeted time for completion thereof;
- (c) the steps taken/being taken by the Government to complete the pending projects within the stipulated time limit and without cost overrun;
- (d) the length of NHs constructed during the said period in the country, State/ UT-wise;
- (e) the details of State Highways converted into NHs in the State of Karnataka during the said period;
- (f) the target set by the Union Government for construction of NH in Karnataka during the current financial year along with the funds allocated for the purpose; and
- (g) the details of mechanism established by the Government to monitor and check the construction quality and maintenance work of NHs ?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

(SHRI NITIN JAIRAM GADKARI)

- (a) The State/UT-wise details of the on-going NH projects in the country as on 31.03.2019 are at Annexure-I. The details of funds allocated and utilised for construction/ development of NHs during the last three years and the current year are at Annexure-II.

(b) & (c) There are 453 development projects under this Ministry which are delayed mainly due to land acquisition, utility shifting, non-availability of soil/ aggregate, poor performance of contractors, environment/ forest/ wildlife clearances, ROB & RUB issues with Railways, public agitation for additional facilities, arbitration/ contractual disputes with contractors etc. To fast track these projects, various steps such as streamlining of land acquisition & environment clearances, premium re-scheduling, close coordination with other Ministries, revamping of dispute resolution mechanism, frequent review meetings with project developers, State Governments and contractors at various levels etc. have been taken up.

(d) The State/UT-wise details of length of NHs constructed in the country during the last three years are at Annexure-III.

(e) The details of State Roads including State Highways converted into NHs in the State of Karnataka during the last three years are as follows:

(f) The target set by the Ministry for construction of NHs in Karnataka during the current financial year 2019-20 is 375 km. An amount of Rs. 625 Crore have been allocated for development of NHs in the State of Karnataka during current financial year 2019-20 at present.

(g) There is a well-established mechanism for monitoring/ testing of quality of construction/ development of work of NHs by engaging a Consultancy firm of repute as Supervision Consultant/ Independent Consultant/ Authority Engineer. They supervise/ monitor the quality of work as per procedures laid down in various codes published by Indian Roads Congress (IRC), manuals & Ministry's specifications for Road and Bridge works, etc. The routine inspections are also done by departmental Engineers on regular basis to assess quality of construction and maintenance of road.
