Sports Infrastructure in Assam

5455. SHRI PRADYUT BORDOLOI:

Will the Minister of YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is aware that the existing infrastructure for sports is in very bad shape in Nowgong in Assam;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the steps being taken to revive and maintain these facilities;
- (c) whether the Government proposes to start/open up a full-fledged sports academy to promote young talents inNowgong; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the steps taken by the Government in this regard?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) FOR YOUTH AFFAIRS & SPORTS { SHRI KIREN RIJIJU }

- (a) and (b) 'Sports' being a State subject the responsibility for developing sports infrastructure, including in Nowgong in Assam, rests with the State Government. Central Government supplements efforts of the State Government by providing expert training facilities in Sports Authority of India (SAI) Centres, supports to National Sports Federations (NSFs) and support under Khelo India Scheme. SAI infrastructure does not exist at Nowgong. Information relating to sports training facilities provided by this Ministry in Assam is given in Annexure I.
- (c) and (d) There is no proposal under consideration of this Ministry to start/open up a full-fledged sports academy in Nowgong. Information of infrastructure projects sanctioned under Khelo India Scheme for Assam is at Annexure II.
