**FUNDS FOR URBAN BASIC AMENITIES IN MAHARASHTRA**

**No. 5461. DR. BHARATI PRAVIN PAWAR:**

**Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the Union Government has allocated any funds to State of Maharashtra for implementing the schemes for providing urban basic amenities in the State;**
- (b) if so, the details thereof indicating the funds allocated/released and utilized for the said purpose during each of the last three years and the current year; and**
- (c) the details of works done from the said funds, in the concerned areas?**

- (a) to (c): Yes, Sir. The Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA) facilitates and assists States/Union Territories (UTs) including Maharashtra, through its Missions/Schemes in development of cities and towns covered under these Missions/Schemes. These Schemes support providing urban basic amenities like – water supply, sewerage, parks, community toilets, etc. Funds released to Maharashtra and utilized by the State for these urban development Schemes during the last three years and current year and work done are in Annex.**

**B. Status of work under the Missions in Maharashtra**

**1. Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation**

**The Mission is being implemented in 44 cities in the State. 33 projects costing Rs. 70 crore have been completed. 157 projects worth Rs. 6,999 crore are under implementation and 7 projects with an investment of Rs 730 crore are at various stages of tendering.**

**2. Smart Cities Mission**

**243 projects with an investment of Rs 18,479 crore have been undertaken in 8 Smart Cities in the State. Of these 56 projects costing Rs 1,410 crore have been completed. 127 projects costing Rs 6,731 crore are under implementation and tenders have been invited for 60 projects worth Rs 10,338 crore.**

### **3. Swachh Bharat Mission-Urban**

**6.83 lakh Individual Household Latrines(IHHL) have been completed and another 3,275 are under construction. 1.24 lakh Community Toilets and Public toilets have been constructed and another 561 are under construction. Door to door collection of waste has been implemented in 5,990 wards in the State.**

### **4. Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana-Urban**

**9.85 lakh houses with basic amenities have been sanctioned of which, 3.76 lakh houses have been grounded, out of which 1.86 lakh houses have been completed. A total of 2.07 lakh houses have been occupied which include 1.67 lakh houses from PMAY (U) and 39,817 houses from earlier Urban housing scheme.**

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
