HEALTHCARE FACILITIES IN RURAL AREAS

**5627. SHRI UNMESH BHAIYYASAHEB PATIL:
SHRI B.Y. RAGHAVENDRA:**

Will the Minister of **HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether people in the rural areas have minimal access to healthcare facilities and if so, the details thereof along with the present status of the same in the country, State/UT-wise;
- (b) whether various Government hospitals in rural areas are facing problem of infrastructure and shortage of doctors and other professionals and if so, the details thereof and the reasons therefor;
- (c) whether the Government has conducted any survey regarding the requirement of healthcare facilities in rural areas of the country, if so, the details thereof along with the action plan of the Government to provide better health facilities in these areas;
- (d) whether the Government is considering any mechanism/scheme/plan to train more health professionals and depute them in rural areas and if so, the details thereof; and
- (e) the steps taken/proposed to be taken by the Government to improve/ provide better healthcare services in rural areas of the country?

**ANSWER

(a) to (e): Rural Health Statistics (RHS) is an annual publication, based on Health care administrative data generated by the health care system. RHS provides reliable and updated information on rural health infrastructure and requirements of public health facilities in rural areas. As per the RHS 2017-18, the state-wise details of shortfall of health facilities along with no. of Sub Divisional & District Hospitals, infrastructural facilities available and status of shortage/ vacancy position of human resources at Sub Centre, Primary Health Centres and Community Health Centres are at Annexure-I to Annexure-XI.

“Public Health and Hospital” being a State Subject, the primary responsibility of improving access to healthcare facilities, including infrastructure strengthening and deployment of adequate Human Resource in public health facilities including in rural areas lies with respective State Governments.

To address the healthcare challenges, National Health Mission (NHM) supplements the efforts of the State/UT governments to provide accessible, affordable and quality healthcare to all those who access public health facilities especially in rural areas.

NHM support is provided to States/ UTs for setting up of new facilities as per norms and upgradation of existing facilities for bridging the infrastructure gaps and to fill up the vacancies of Human Resource on contractual basis based on the requirement posed by them.

NHM support is also provided for provision of a host of free services related to maternal health, child health, adolescent health, family planning, universal immunisation programme, and for major diseases such as Tuberculosis, HIV/ AIDS, vector borne diseases like Malaria, Dengue and Kala Azar, Leprosy etc.

Other major initiatives supported under NHM include Janani Shishu Suraksha Karyakram (JSSK) (under which free drugs, free diagnostics, free blood and diet, free transport from home to institution, between facilities in case of a referral and drop back home is provided), Rashtriya Bal Swasthya Karyakram (RBSK) (which provides newborn and child health screening and early interventions services free of cost for birth defects, diseases, deficiencies and developmental delays to improve the quality of survival), implementation of Free Drugs and Free Diagnostics Service Initiatives, PM National Dialysis Programme and implementation of National Quality Assurance Framework in all public health facilities including in rural areas.

Mobile Medical Units (MMUs) & Telemedicine are also being implemented with NHM support to improve healthcare access particularly in rural areas.

As part of Ayushman Bharat, the Government is supporting the States for transformation of Health Sub Centres and Primary Health Centres into 1.5 lakh Health and Wellness Centres across the country by December, 2022 for provision of comprehensive primary care that includes preventive healthcare and health promotion at the community level with continuum of care approach. Further, Ayushman Bharat, Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (AB-PMJAY) provides health coverage up to Rs. 5.00 lakh per family per year to around 10.74 crore poor and vulnerable families as per Socio Economic Caste Census (SECC).

Training of health professionals working in Public Health facilities is a regular activity and required supported is provided to the States/ UTs under NHM. Financial support is also provided to States for providing hard area allowance, performance-based incentives, providing accommodation and transport facilities etc. to enable health professionals to be deputed in rural & remote areas.
