- (a) & (b) The Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities, through its National Institutes, runs the following model schools for specific disabilities:-
  - 1. National Institute for the Empowerment of Persons with Visual Disabilities (Divyangjan), Dehradun, Uttarkhand
  - Model School for the Visually Handicapped (MSVH)
  - 2. National Institute for the Empowerment of Persons with Intellectual Disabilities (Divyangjan), Secunderabad, Telangana
  - Three Special Education Centres at Secunderabad, New Delhi and NOIDA.
  - 3. Pt. Deendayal Upadhyaya National Institute for Persons with Physical Disabilities (Divyangjan), New Delhi
  - Model Integrated Primary School
  - 4. National Institute for Empowerment of Persons with Multiple Disabilities (Divyangjan), Chennai, Tamil Nadu.
  - Model Special Education Centre

There is no such centre/school of National Institutes in Maharashtra.

However, the Department is implementing a scheme namely Deendayal Disabled Rehabilitation Scheme(DDRS) under which grant-in-aid is provided to Non-Governmental Organizations (NGOs) for running on-going special schools. It does not provide funds for opening of special schools under DDRS. A statement indicating State wise details of special schools and number of beneficiaries under DDRS including State of Maharashtra is at Annexure.
