(a) & (b) Indian Railways do not run trains on State-wise basis as railway network cuts across State boundaries. As such, induction of rakes including Linke Hofmann Busch (LHB) is not undertaken on State-wise basis. However, at present, 22 pairs of train services Originating from /Terminating at /Passing through the stations located in the State of Kerala are being operated with LHB coaches. Besides, replacement of additional trains with LHB coaches is an on-going process on Indian Railways and is being undertaken in a phased

(c)46 Base Kitchens/Kitchen Units have been upgraded by IRCTC during the last 2 years. The latest kitchen equipments such as Tilting Bratt pans, Tilting boiling kettle, Vegetable cutting machine, Chapati making machine including peda cutting machine et al. have been installed in the upgraded Kitchen Units.

In addition, to ensure real time monitoring of Kitchen activities, CCTV cameras have also been installed in 39 Base Kitchen, Food Safety Supervisors have been deployed at Kitchens to monitor compliance of food safety norms and hygienic practices.
