**CONSTRUCTION OF ROB IN MISRIKH**

**†774. SHRI ASHOK KUMAR RAWAT:**

**Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:**

- (a) whether the Union Government has taken or proposes to take any steps to construct an overbridge at the railway line crossing under Sandila-Bilhaur-Kachhauna municipality/nagar panchayat of the Misrikh parliamentary constituency of the State of Uttar Pradesh;**
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and**
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor?**

**(a) to (c): There are 3 Nos. of Level Crossings (LCs) i.e. 247, 248, 249 near Sandila Railway Station. All these LCs qualify for their replacement by Road over Bridge (ROB) on cost sharing basis with State Government as traffic density of these LCs is more than 1 lakh Train Vehicle Unit (TVU). Accordingly, State Government has been approached to submit the formal proposal for consent of ROB at these locations alongwith necessary consents for sharing of cost and closure of LC. No proposal in this regard has, however, been received from State Government.**
