WHITEFIELD-HINDUPUR RAILWAY LINE

780. SHRI S. MUNISWAMY:

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) the present status of Whitefield-Hindupur Railway line in Karnataka;**
- (b) whether any funds have been allocated/released for the said railway line; and**
- (c) if so, the details thereof?**

ANSWER

(SHRI PIYUSH GOYAL)

(a): On Whitefield-Hindupur rail route, Whitefield-Krishnarajapuram & Channasandra-Yelahanka sections are double Broad Gauge lines. Further, work on Yelahanka-Penukonda via Hindupur doubling and Bangalore Cantonment-Krishnarajapuram-Whitefield 3rd & 4th line have been taken up.

(b) and (c): Yelahanka-Penukonda doubling project (121 Km) was sanctioned in 2015-16. Latest anticipated cost of the project is ₹ 958.37 crores and Budget Outlay of ₹ 132 crores has been made for this project during 2019-20.

Bangalore Cantonment-Krishnarajapuram-Whitefield 3rd & 4th line project (37.89 Km) was sanctioned in March, 2018. Latest anticipated cost of the project is ₹ 493 crores and Budget Outlay of ₹ 51 crores has been made for this project during 2019-20.
