ACCIDENTS ON DELHI-ALWAR NH-248

†893. SHRI DHARAMBIR SINGH:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is aware that hundreds of accidents occur in a month on Delhi to Alwar via Sohna-Nuh (NH-248) from Nuh to Rajasthan border due to double lane and heavy local traffic;
- (b) if so, whether there is any project to convert it to a four lane; and
- (c) if so, the details thereof and the time by which it is likely to be done?

ANSWER

- (a) The road stretch Nuh to Rajasthan border is part of Section Sohna-Rajasthan border of NH to 248 A which has been entrusted to National Highway Authority of India (NHAI) since May, 2017. The Ministry collects data/information in the prescribed format from the Police Department of all States/UTs on total number of persons killed and injured in road accidents in the country and on National Highways.
- (b) & (c) At present, there is no proposal to convert the Nuh to Rajasthan Section of Delhi-Alwar Road (NH-248A) to four lane.
