PROVISIONS OF AIR CONDITIONERS ATCHEAPER RATES

†948. SHRI UDAY PRATAP SINGH:

Will the Minister of POWER be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government proposes to provide air conditioners at cheaper rates on the lines of the cheaper LED bulbs throughout the country;

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) whether the Government has setup any mechanism in this regard and if so, the details thereof;

(d) the time frame fixed for making the said air conditioners available in the Indian markets; and

(e) whether the Government has allocated/proposes to allocate any funds for implementation of the said project and if so, the details thereof?

ANSWER

(a) to (d): Energy Efficiency Services Limited (EESL), a joint venture of PSUs under the Ministry of Power, has developed a Super-Efficient Air Conditioning Programme for providing Super-Efficient air conditioners (ACs) to customers at affordable rates in the market through demand aggregation and economies of scale. The aim of this pilot programme is to deploy 50,000 Super-efficient ACs.

EESL has signed MoUs with BSES Rajdhani Power Limited, BSES Yamuna Power Limited, Tata Power and Thane Municipal Corporation to distribute Super-efficient ACs to consumers of areas under their respective jurisdiction through a web-based demand aggregation model.

(e): No funds have been allocated by the Government of India for this purpose. The programme envisages provision of the entire capital investment by EESL, which EESL recovers from customers.
