- (a) As on date, there are a total of 128 aircraft in the operating fleet (narrow body 79 and wide body 49) of Air India Limited. Out of these 128 aircraft, 19 aircraft are non-operational/grounded due to shortage of engines and other components apart from the aircraft under daily scheduled maintenance as on 24.06.2019.
- (b) The average utilization of aircraft in the fleet of Air India for FY 2018-19 is presently as under:

Type of Fleet

Per day Average Utilisation

Airbus Fleet (A320 family)

10.66 hrs.

Boeing Fleet

11.14 hrs.

- (c) & (d) As on date, no aircraft in the operating fleet of Air India Limited has completed its utilization period.
- (e) At present, Air India has no immediate plans to procure new aircraft in place of old aircraft.
- (f) Does not arise in view of (e) above.
